Membership Development Committee (Vice Chair Dennis Boyden): Responsible for planning and implementing programs and events designed to recruit and retain members. - Membership Recruitment – Identify, solicit and recruit new members. All programs and activities support this effort.
- Member Services – Evaluate and recommend products and services which provide direct enhancements and tangible benefits of membership; Communicate and promote member services.

Technology Committee (Vice Chair Stacey Key): Responsible for the development and implementation of action plans that increase the public's awareness of the League's activities projects and programs.
